Prevention Works Joint Task Force and Coalition is a collaborative network of Affiliate Offices joined together for shared training, resources and advocacy. The need for coordination, communication, and collaboration on a national and international level is currently being addressed through Prevention Works: Child Abuse and Sex Trafficking Joint Task Force.

The mission of the Task Force is to utilize the power of community engagement through training to protect the citizens of every community from perpetrators and systems of sexual exploitation while concurrently working to advocate for the victims. The Task Force functions by a targeted, strategic framework consisting of the formation of “Affiliate Offices” and “Coalition members” within communities across this nation and abroad. The PW Task Force will seek to address the five fundamentals of the child abuse and sex trafficking continuum: **Susceptibility - Recruitment - Exploitation - Rescue - Rehabilitation.**

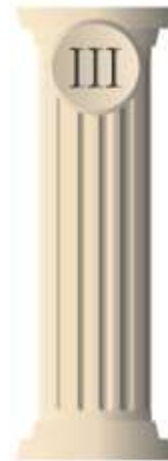
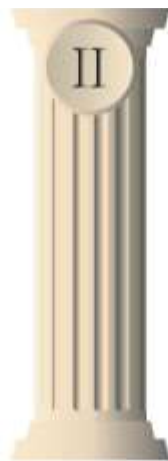
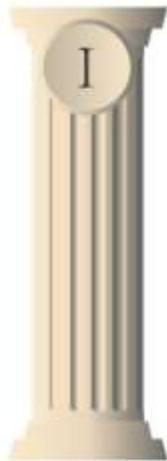
We have identified 3 pillars of prevention

Awareness

Training

Advocacy



Three Pillars of prevention will be the focal point of the PW Task Force:

I. Awareness:

- a. Community Awareness and Education
- b. Youth Aware And Safety (including At-Risk Youth)
- c. Deterring Traffickers And Buyers

II. Training:

- a. Community Training
- b. Youth
- c. Business and Organization sector - Coalition

III. Advocacy:

- a. Survivor Support (healing resources)
- b. Survivor Thriving (transitional resources)
- c. Legislative advocacy

The nationwide and international PW Joint Task Force initiative will be comprised of Affiliate members, individual members and Coalition members.

Affiliate Office and International Affiliate Office is an entity that will have individual volunteers from the community and Coalition members (business and organizations). It is the responsibility of the Affiliate Offices (AO or IAO) to conceptualize and develop new events and innovative programs for their community as well as the implementation of campaigns and the dissemination of information as given by the corporate office.

Affiliate Office and International Affiliate Office will also be responsible for training the community with curriculum approved and supported by the corporate office ONLY. Any additional training must go through proper approvals prior to usage.

Our goal is to achieve the anticipated community-level outcomes. These outcomes may be, but are not limited to: increased cooperation, coordination, and collaboration among multidisciplinary entities throughout the state that each affiliate is representing; new and/or improved policies, protocols, processes, tools and curriculums; and increased knowledge, awareness, and skills.

Wealth Management Ministries, Inc. and Prevention Works Task Force and Coalition are not held liable or responsible for any adverse or illegal actions/activities of the Affiliates, organization or company.

AO and IAO must comply with the Code of Conduct (given upon application approval).

The Corporate Office of Prevention Works Joint Task Force and Coalition reserves the right to close any affiliate office (domestic and/or international) for any reason deemed necessary.

Each Affiliate Office (domestic and international) reserve the right to close their office for any reason, however, must give written notice 30 days in advance.

How it works:

- 1). An interested Affiliate and International Affiliate Office will submit application along with processing fee of \$100 (includes criminal background check, territorial assignment and administrative fees).
- 2). If he/she or organization qualifies, they will be assigned to the city applied for.
- 3). Training will be offered to the Affiliates for Child Abuse and Sex Trafficking prevention.
- 4). Affiliate Office and International Affiliate Office will be responsible for the on-going training for the prevention of Child Abuse and Sex Trafficking for their community/city.
- 5). Affiliate Office and International Affiliate Office must raise their own funds for events, campaigns and programs. Corporate campaigns and events will be supported accordingly.
- 6). Affiliate Office and International Affiliate Office are welcome to collect membership fees as suggested below to cover overhead:

Coalition members: \$50 per month

Individuals: \$25 per month

Affiliate Offices must turn in membership roster monthly for their memberships to be official.

- 7). Affiliates and International Affiliate Office may request tax deductible donations for their organization IF they have a their own non-profit/tax exemption. They must use their own tax exemption identification; not that of Wealth Management Ministries, Inc. Please seek tax accountant or CPA.
- 8). Affiliate and International Affiliate Office members are NOT entities of Wealth Management Ministries, Inc. **It is a collaborative network of likeminded people, organizations and businesses who are focused on preventing child abuse and sex trafficking.**

9). Qualifying Affiliates: individuals, businesses, organizations and faith-based organizations.

10). Monthly Affiliate member fee is \$100 per month paid to the corporate office once the office has enough income from coalition members and individual members to cover the corporate monthly fee.

11). For marketing purposes, the logo can be used with prior approval ONLY. The language used with logo can only be as follows: Prevention Works Joint Task Force Affiliate Office (or International Affiliate Office) a Collaborative Network.
